## THE LORD'S PRAYER - Our Daily Bread

SCRIPTURE: [Matthew 6:11](#)

STORY VIDEO: [R/Kids Story Time- "How to Pray" from The Jesus Storybook Bible](#)

WORSHIP SONG: [The Lord's Prayer](#)

**MAIN TAKEAWAY:** God has everything that we need and gives us what we need when we need it. He provides for us because He is our good Father.

**FAMILY PRAYER:** God, thank you for giving us everything we need. Thank you that you know what we need before we ask, but you still love talking with us about it. You are a good Father and we love you- help us to give to others because you have given to us! Amen.

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### 0 - 18 MONTHS

**ACTIVITY:** Show your baby the sign for "[Give](#)". Review previous weeks' signs of "[Holy](#)", "[Father](#)", "[Pray](#)", and "[King](#)". Practice the signs with your baby and gently guide their hands to do the sign with you. Tell them that Jesus gives us all that we need!

**CRAFT:** Using paper scraps, fabric, or any other baby-safe art supplies you have around the house, assist your baby in creating a masterpiece to put in your window or on your mailbox to greet anyone who passes by! Write a note to include with it that says "Our child created this art for you- we're praying for you and hope you have a great day!"

**SERVICE PROJECT:** Pray for people who make deliveries or provide essential services in your neighborhood. If you get a delivery, when your trash or recycling gets collected, or when your mail comes- wave to the person and say hello! Tell them you prayed for them and that you're thankful for them.

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## 18 MONTHS - 3 YEARS

**ACTIVITY:** Teach your toddler the sign for "[Give](#)". Review previous weeks' signs of "[King](#)", "[Name](#)", "[Holy](#)", "[Father](#)", "[Pray](#)", and "[Thank you](#)". Say "Jesus gives us everything we need!" and clap with your toddler.

**CRAFT:** Make a sign to put in your window to say hello to your neighbors! Give your toddler a blank paper, crayons, and any other art supplies you have around and let them create a masterpiece! Write a note to include with it that says, "Our child created this art for you- we're praying for you and hope you have a great day!" Hang it up in your front window, on your door, or on your mailbox to give a greeting to anyone who passes by.

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## 3 - 5 YEARS

**ACTIVITY:** Review last week's signs of "[King](#)", "[Father](#)", "[Pray](#)", "[Thank you](#)", "[Jesus](#)", "[Name](#)", and "[Holy](#)". This week, teach your PreK-er how to sign "[Give](#)". Watch a group of kids signing the Lord's Prayer [HERE](#) and follow along! Try to find times in the video when the kids are signing the words you learned and cheer for your child if they spot it!

**CRAFT:** Make a sign to put in your window to say hello to your neighbors! Give your child a blank paper, crayons, and any other art supplies you have around and let them create a masterpiece! Write a note to include with it that says "Our child created this art for you- we're praying for you and hope you have a great day!" Hang it up in your front window, on your door, or on your mailbox to give a greeting to anyone who passes by.

**ACTIVITY:** Learn how to sign the entire Lord's Prayer by clicking [HERE](#). This will be an ongoing activity throughout the series. If there are multiple children in your house, have a contest to see who can memorize it the furthest each day. To connect with other families, post a video of your child doing this activity to your social media page or on a text and tag other friends to challenge them!

**CRAFT:** Make a sign to put in your window to say hello to your neighbors! Ask your child what they would like to create to encourage people who pass by your house, using just the supplies you have at home. If they need an idea, suggest that they write a note, draw a picture, or create a piece of art for people with a note that tells them we're praying for them and that we hope you have a great day. Allow your child to hang it in a safe place that can be seen by people passing by your home. If your child is a performer, have them watch for people passing by and sing, dance, or perform at a safe distance as they walk by!
