THE LORD'S PRAYER - Deliver Us

SCRIPTURE: [Matthew 6:13](#)

STORY VIDEO: [God's Story- Prayer](#)

WORSHIP SONG: [The Lord's Prayer](#)

MAIN TAKEAWAY: God is our deliverer. When we are scared, in trouble, or need God's help in any way, we can call out to Him. He delivers us from what makes us scared, sad, or what gets us in trouble and brings us close to Him.

FAMILY PRAYER: Pray the Lord's Prayer together as a family- "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name. Your Kingdom come, Your will be done on Earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For yours is the Kingdom, and the power, and the glory forever. AMEN!"

0 - 18 MONTHS

ACTIVITY: Show your baby the sign for "[Deliver](#)". Review previous weeks' signs in the following order for an abbreviated version of the whole prayer! "[Pray](#)", "[Father](#)", "[Holy](#)", "[King](#)", "[Give](#)", "[Forgive](#)", "[Deliver](#)". Practice the signs with your baby and gently guide their hands to do the sign with you. Tell them that God is our deliverer!

CRAFT: Do a shadow puppet theater with your baby using toy trucks, cars, or boxes- anything that could be used to deliver something. Shine a flashlight or lamp on to a blank wall (turn off other lights in the room) and put the shadow puppet items in front of the light so their shadows reflect on the wall. Allow your baby to try their own shadow puppets with their hands and body!

SERVICE PROJECT: Pray specifically for people who deliver things to you and to others. If you have extra supplies available, set out a box on your porch or next to your mailbox with water bottles and individually wrapped snacks for delivery people who come by your house. Make a sign that says, "Thank you for delivering our things! We're praying for you- enjoy a snack!"

18 MONTHS - 3 YEARS

ACTIVITY: Show your toddler the signs for "[Deliver](#)" and "[Amen](#)". Review previous weeks' signs in the following order for an abbreviated version of the whole prayer! "[Pray](#)", "[Thank you](#)", "[Father](#)", "[Holy](#)", "[Name](#)", "[King](#)", "[Give](#)", "[Forgive](#)", "[Deliver](#)", "[Amen](#)". Say, "God is our deliverer!" and clap with your toddler.

CRAFT: Do a shadow puppet theater with your toddler using toy trucks, cars, or boxes- anything that could be used to deliver something. Shine a flashlight or lamp on to a blank wall (turn off other lights in the room) and put the shadow puppet items in front of the light so their shadows reflect on the wall. Show your toddler how to do some simple shadow puppets with their hands (tutorial [HERE](#)).

SERVICE PROJECT: Pray specifically for people who deliver things to you and to others. If you have extra supplies available, set out a box on your porch or next to your mailbox with water bottles and individually wrapped snacks for delivery people who come by your house. Make a sign that says, "Thank you for delivering our things! We're praying for you- enjoy a snack!"

3 - 5 YEARS

ACTIVITY: Teach your PreK-er how to sign "[Deliver](#)" and "[Amen](#)". Review previous week's signs in order for an abbreviated version of the whole prayer! "[Pray](#)", "[Thank you](#)", "[Jesus](#)", "[Father](#)", "[Holy](#)", "[Name](#)", "[King](#)", "[Give](#)", "[Bread](#)", "[Forgive](#)", "[Deliver](#)", "[Amen](#)". Watch a group of kids signing the Lord's Prayer [HERE](#) and follow along!

CRAFT: Create a "delivery" paper airplane using the template found [HERE](#). Ask your child what they want their plane to deliver to people and have them decorate it accordingly. Help them out if needed, and see how far you can make it fly! No matter how the plane flies, however, remind your child that God will always be there when we call Him.

If you have extra supplies available, set out a box on your porch or next to your mailbox with water bottles and individually wrapped snacks for delivery people who come by your house. KINDERGARTEN-4TH GRADE

ACTIVITY: Learn how to sign the entire Lord's Prayer by reviewing the video used throughout this series by clicking [HERE](#). Have your child(ren) stand with their backs to the video and try to sign it from memory! Learn it alongside them and have a contest to see who can sign the most. If you have other people in your home, get creative and do boys vs. girls, mom vs. dad, sibling vs. sibling, etc. Bring it all together by signing as a family and thanking God that He hears us however we speak (or sign) to Him!

CRAFT: Create a "delivery" paper airplane! Find tutorials on many different types of paper airplanes by clicking [HERE](#). Have your child decorate the plane to look like a delivery plane- get creative with what it is delivering and what it looks like. Join in the fun, make a plane yourself, and have a fly-off to see whose plane flies the farthest! No matter how their paper airplane flies, remind your child that God is our reliable deliverer and He will always be there for us when we call Him.
