THE LORD'S PRAYER - Hallowed be Your Name

SCRIPTURE: Matthew 6:9

WORSHIP SONG: [No One Like You](#)

MAIN TAKEAWAY: God's name is holy and good. When we follow Him, we want to see His name lifted high over all the earth and in our everyday lives.

FAMILY PRAYER: God, thank You that you are holy and good. Thank you for Jesus and how He shows us and gives us Your goodness and holiness. Help us to lift your name up high in everything we do and in our hearts. We love you! Amen.

0 - 18 MONTHS

ACTIVITY: Show your baby the sign for "[Holy](#)". Review last week's signs of "[Father](#)" and "[Pray](#)". Practice the signs with your baby and gently guide their hands to do the sign with you. Tell them that God's name is holy and good, and we want to lift it high!

CRAFT: Write your baby's name on a paper. Gently help them trace the letters with their finger. Tell your baby why you gave them their name. Next, tell them that God's name is holy and good and He loves us.

SERVICE PROJECT: Do a thankfulness walk around your house while holding your baby. In each room, find something to thank God for providing for you. As you thank Him for each thing, raise up your hands in the air and say "Thank you Jesus! We lift your name up high!"

18 MONTHS - 3 YEARS

ACTIVITY: Teach your toddler the sign for "[Name](#)" and "[Holy](#)". Review last week's signs of "[Father](#)", "[Pray](#)", and "[Thank you](#)". Cheer and clap when they do it correctly and do it again with them. Say, "God is our Father, and His name is holy!" and clap with your toddler.

CRAFT: Write your toddler's name on a piece of paper. Have them use a crayon (or assist them with a crayon if they're younger) to trace their name. Tell them why you gave them their name, and that God's name is holy and good and He loves us.

SERVICE PROJECT: Do a thankfulness walk around your house with your toddler (pro tip- say "I bet you can't catch me!" while fake-running to the room. Works *almost* every time.) Say "THANK YOU JESUS! WE LIFT YOUR NAME UP HIGH!" and raise up your hands in the air as you walk to the room. Find a couple of items to thank God for together. The more ridiculous-sounding your voice, the better!

3 - 5 YEARS

ACTIVITY: Teach your child the sign for "[Name](#)" and "[Holy](#)". Review last week's signs of "[Father](#)", "[Pray](#)", "[Thank you](#)" and "[Jesus](#)". Then, watch a group of kids signing the Lord's Prayer ([HERE](#)) and follow along! Try to find times in the video when the kids are signing the words you learned and cheer for your child if they spot it!

CRAFT: Write or print out your child's name. Let them decorate the page, and then try to cut or tear just their name out of the paper (monitor for safety but allow them to do it on their own). Tell them the story of why you gave them their name. When they've finished cutting or tearing out their name from the page, tell them that even though we might not always be perfect, God is always good and perfect and He loves us and makes us perfect through Jesus.

SERVICE PROJECT: Do a thankfulness walk around your house with your child. Pretend like you're a tour guide, introducing your child to each room of your house and saying things that you're thankful for in that room. Ask your child what they're thankful for in each room (nothing's off the table- even TP is something to be thankful for in this season!) After you visit each room or after each item you find to be thankful for, say "THANK YOU JESUS! WE LIFT YOUR NAME UP HIGH!" together as a family and raise up your hands in the air.

KINDERGARTEN-2nd GRADE

ACTIVITY: Learn how to sign the entire Lord's Prayer by watching [this video](#). This will be an ongoing activity throughout the series. If there are multiple children in your house, have a contest to see who can memorize it the furthest each day. To connect with other families, post a video of your child doing this activity to your social media page and tag other friends to challenge them!

CRAFT: Have your child write their name on a piece of paper using any writing implement you have at the house. For extra fun, find a bubble letter tutorial [HERE](#). Tell them the story of how they got their name, and tell them that even though we might not always be perfect, God is always good and perfect and He loves us and makes us perfect through Jesus.

SERVICE PROJECT: Have your child conduct a thankfulness walk around your house. Give them a few minutes to put together a tour agenda/costumes/etc as needed. If your child prefers to write out a tour or draw a map of your house, that works too! Once everything's prepared, go on a thankfulness walk through your house. Before you leave each room, say "THANK YOU JESUS! WE LIFT YOUR NAME UP HIGH!" together as a family and raise your hands in the air.

3rd-4th GRADE

ACTIVITY: Learn how to sign the entire Lord's Prayer by watching [this video](#). This will be an ongoing activity throughout the series. If there are multiple children in your house, have a contest to see who can memorize it the furthest each day. To connect with other families, post a video of your child doing this activity to your social media page and tag other friends to challenge them!

CRAFT: Have your child write their signature in large print on a paper. Find a cursive letter tutorial [HERE](#). Ask them if they can tell you why they have the name they have, and tell them the story if they don't know. Explain that God's name being "hallowed" also means it's "holy"- unique, other, and perfect. Tell them that even though we might not always be perfect, God is always good and perfect and He loves us and makes us perfect through Jesus.

SERVICE PROJECT: Ask your child to conduct a thankfulness walk around your house. Give them a few minutes to put together a tour agenda/costumes/etc as needed. If your child prefers to write out a tour or draw a map of your house, that works too! Once everything's prepared, go on a thankfulness walk through your house. Before you leave each room, say "THANK YOU JESUS! WE LIFT YOUR NAME UP HIGH!" together as a family and raise your hands in the air. Bonus activity- do a 1 minute clean up of each room as you're doing your tour!
