PEACEMAKING - "The Body" Week 2

SCRIPTURE: [Romans 14:19](#) - "...make every effort to do what leads to peace and mutual edification."

WORSHIP SONG: [Peace Like a River](#)

MAIN TAKEAWAY: The church is an important part of bringing God's peace to the world. He could do it all on His own, but He loves us so much that He wants us to share His love and peace with each other and the rest of the world!

FAMILY PRAYER: Jesus, thank you that You are peace. Thank You that we get to be part of the church that means so much to You. Help us share Your love and Your peace with our church family, our family, our neighbors, and people who don't know You. We love You!

0 - 18 MONTHS

ACTIVITY: Gather a few of your baby's toys that look different or have different functions. Put them together in a heart shape on the floor and let your baby play with them. Tell your baby that the church has many different people in it, but that God brings us all together!

18 MONTHS - 3 YEARS

ACTIVITY: Play "church" with your toddler! Set up different kinds of stuffed animals, dolls, or any of your child's favorite toys and play the worship song for them (or watch the service together as a family!). Pray with your child over their gathered "church", and for the church all around the world!

3 - 5 YEARS

ACTIVITY: Using the coloring page or any paper you have available, have your child draw a picture for one of their friends from church, friends from the neighborhood, or family members. If you have stamps, send it to their home address (tape envelope instead of licking it for safety!) Write a note to include in the letter to encourage the person it's being sent to- ask your child for suggestions on what to say to share God's peace with that person. If you don't have stamps, you can leave it on their porch, take a picture and text it to their parents, or any other creative and safe solutions you can think of! Pray for the person as your child is drawing and invite your child to pray with you.

KINDERGARTEN-4TH GRADE

ACTIVITY: Ask your child who they are missing the most right now. Allow them to process through any grief by listening and acknowledging that missing people is hard. Using the coloring page or any other art supplies you have at hand, have your child make a drawing or write a letter to the person they're missing. If you have stamps, send it to their home address. If you don't have stamps, you can leave it on their porch, take a picture and text it to their parents, or any other creative and safe solutions you can think of! Pray for the person with your child.
