## PSALM 23 - He is With Me

SCRIPTURE: [Psalm 23:6](#)

STORY VIDEO: [R/Kids Story Time Week 8- Psalm 23](#)

WORSHIP SONGS: [Psalm Song](#)

**MAIN TAKEAWAY:** The book of Psalms in the Bible is a book of songs written to God and about God. Psalm 23:6 tells us that when we belong to God, He is with us and we will be with Him forever.

**FAMILY PRAYER:** Jesus, we love you! Thank You for being with us. Thank You for not leaving us. Help us remember that You're there, especially when we don't feel like You are.

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### 0 - 18 MONTHS

**ACTIVITY:** Play peek-a-boo with your baby. Say, "Where am I? THERE I am!" in a fun voice. Tell your baby that God is with us, even when we can't see Him or feel His presence.

**SERVICE PROJECT:** Ask God to bring someone to your mind who needs to know that He is with them. Pray with your baby for that person and reach out to them to let them know you're praying for them and that God is always with them.

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### 18 MONTHS - 3 YEARS

**ACTIVITY:** Play hide and seek with your child. Say, "Where am I?" and go into another room. Call out for your child until they find you and when they do, say "I love you! Here I am!" Have your child take a turn hiding and go find them. Tell your child that God is always with them, even when they can't see Him or feel His presence.

**SERVICE PROJECT:** Ask God to bring someone to your mind who needs to know that He is with them. Pray with your child for that person and reach out to them to let them know you're praying for them and that God is always with them.

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## 3 - 5 YEARS

**ACTIVITY:** Play hide and seek with your child around your house. Have your child count to 10 while you go hide, and if they have trouble finding you, say "I'm here and I love you!" Switch roles and let your child hide while you go find them. Tell your child that God is always with them, even when they can't see Him or feel His presence.

**SERVICE PROJECT:** Ask God to bring someone to your mind who needs to know that He is with them. Pray with your child for that person and reach out to them to let them know you're praying for them and that God is always with them.

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## KINDERGARTEN-4TH GRADE

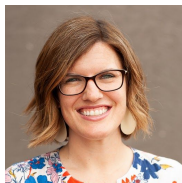
**ACTIVITY:** Stand in a circle as a family or stand face to face with your child and play a game of Psalm 23 memory catch! Using a foam ball or other soft object, toss it back and forth as the person holding the object says one word of the verse thus far. This week, we'll be saying the chapter in its entirety! (*Psalm 23:1-6; The Lord is My Shepherd. I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for His name's sake. Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; My cup overflows. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord forever.*) If you've memorized the whole thing, treat yourselves to something special for your hard work throughout this series! Remind your child that the purpose of memorizing scripture is for it to help us love Jesus and others more. If you'd like to do more activities, add the activity listed in the 3-5 year old section.

**QUESTION OF THE WEEK:** Ask your child, "When have you felt like God is with you? When have you felt like God isn't with you?"

**SERVICE PROJECT:** Ask God to bring someone to your mind who needs to know that He is with them. Pray with your child for that person and reach out to them to let them know you're praying for them and that God is always with them.
