WORSHIP SONG: Standing on the Promises of God by Yancy

MAIN TAKEAWAY: God has made many promises to us in His word, the Bible. For those who are in Christ, he has given the Holy Spirit as a guarantee that his promises will not be broken. 0 - 18 MONTHS

ACTIVITY: Tell your child your testimony, how you became "in Christ." After sharing, play the worship song again, bouncing and dancing with your baby to celebrate the promises He has flooded on you because you belong to Christ.

18 MONTHS - 3 YEARS

ACTIVITY: Tell your child your testimony, how you became "in Christ." After sharing, have a family dance party by playing the worship song again, bouncing and dancing with your child to celebrate the promises he has flooded on you being in Christ.

PRAYER PROJECT: Write a list of your neighbors and put it on your refrigerator. Pray for them to be in Christ and ask God for the opportunity to share the good news of Jesus with them.

3 - 5 YEARS

ACTIVITY: Tell your child your testimony, how you became “in Christ.” After sharing, have a family dance party by playing the worship song again, bouncing and dancing with your child to celebrate the promises he has flooded on you being in Christ.

KINDERGARTEN-4TH GRADE

ACTIVITY: Tell your child your testimony, how you became “in Christ.” After sharing, have a family dance party by playing the worship song again, bouncing and dancing with your child to celebrate the promises he has flooded on you being in Christ.
